PART II. RESEARCH, TEACHING AND CLINICAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Narrative Report of Research, Teaching, and Clinical Contributions:

Main contributions are (1) conducting research on **family treatment** and **family processes** among individuals with alcoholism and other drug problems; and (2) providing training and clinical services related to this research.

Family treatment research has examined behavioral couples therapy (BCT). BCT sees the substance abusing patient with the spouse to build support for sobriety by arranging a daily "sobriety contract" in which the patient states his or her intent not to drink or use drugs and the spouse expresses support for the patient's efforts to stay abstinent. BCT also teaches effective communication skills, and increases positive couple and family activities because these relationship factors are conducive to sobriety. Studies conducted in the Counseling for Alcoholics' Marriages (CALM) Project reveal that BCT for alcoholics and drug abusers produces better abstinence rates and fewer marital separations over a 2-year follow-up period than individually based treatment. Outcomes after BCT show substantial and significant reductions in domestic violence and very favorable cost benefit and cost-effectiveness results. Cost savings due to reduced hospitalizations and jailings after BCT are over five times greater than the cost of delivering the BCT program. This and other work has made BCT the treatment of choice for married/cohabiting substance abusers. These findings also led to ongoing naturalistic "clinical effectiveness" studies of BCT in which large samples of both male and female alcoholics are being treated with BCT to assess the generalizability of positive findings from controlled studies, to examine predictors and patterns of response to BCT in clinically meaningful terms, and to identify patients most and least likely to benefit from BCT.

Family process research has targeted domestic violence, expressed emotion, and other processes. We recently showed for the first time that domestic violence is reduced after BCT for alcoholism; in fact, violence is almost nonexistent among those alcoholics who remain completely abstinent after treatment. We also showed for the first time that spouses' negative expressed emotion (mainly high levels of criticism) at entry to a BCT program predicts subsequent relapse among alcoholics as it does in schizophrenia, mood and eating disorders. These findings have led to ongoing work to determine among patients receiving more typical individual treatment for alcoholism whether domestic violence is reduced and whether expressed emotion predicts relapse. Other work has examined marital and sexual adjustment among substance abusing patients, the adjustment of the children in these families, and the impact of a patient's family history of alcoholism on the outcome of their own treatment for alcoholism.

Research and clinical training has involved over 50 pre- or postdoctoral fellows, 12 of whom have obtained their own research funding after their fellowship. More than 20 fellows have coauthored at least one publication with me, and over 90 of my publications have been coauthored with fellows.

Clinical service has involved directing the Counseling for Alcoholics' Marriages (CALM) Project which provides therapy to over 100 alcoholic/drug abusing patients and their spouses yearly at the Brockton VA Medical Center and other sites.

REPORT OF CLINICAL ACTIVITIES

Description of Clinical Practice

I direct the Counseling for Alcoholics' Marriages (CALM) Project, a clinical and research program at the Brockton campus of the VA Boston Healthcare System and that provides therapy to over 100 alcoholic/drug abusing patients and their spouses yearly.

Patient Load

I have provided or directly supervised the therapy for 20 or more alcoholic/drug abusing patients and their spouses yearly for the past 25 years.

Clinical Contributions

The Counseling for Alcoholics' Marriages (CALM) Project behavioral couples therapy treatment protocol for

alcoholism and drug abuse has been recognized as (1) a treatment method with evidence for its effectiveness that should be replicated by other investigators by an American Psychological Association panel; (2) an empirically supported, cost-effective treatment method that should be adopted by substance abuse treatment programs by a recent review article in the Journal of Studies on Alcohol; (3) an effective treatment protocol to include in a manual for substance abuse counselors by the National Institute on Drug Abuse; (4) a useful treatment method by substance abuse treatment programs in Ohio, Calgary, and other locations that have adopted the model; (5) a major basis for a self-help book completed by an author totally independent of O'Farrell based on his publications in the scientific literature.
